

Servants' Covenant

In order to strengthen the unity of the church toward fulfilling our mission and vision statements, we are requiring all officers, counselors, Sunday school teachers and Worship leaders enter into a Servants' Covenant with the church. The purpose of this covenant is two-fold.

First, since you have committed yourself toward serving in the church, this covenant forms a tangible action in which you make yourself accountable to the local congregation of the Evangelical Chinese Church and the Lord Jesus Christ who is the head of the church universal. In signing this agreement, you enter into covenant to:

- 1) To spend the necessary time to be open to God's leading each day through personal devotions and prayer.
- 2) To fulfill the requirements of training set by cell group advisors and the church. This may include attending monthly reading assignments and reflective "homework" attending counselors or cole/servants' team meeting, joining your officer/counselor team to attend training seminars.
- 3) Be accountable to church leadership for nurturing, teaching, correction, and discipline.

Second, this covenant makes the church accountable to supporting and sustaining your personal spiritual walk and your ministry in this local congregation. Within the resource available, the church will endeavor to provide spiritual guidance, ministry training, and regular support and encouragement through a variety of means.

This covenant is effective for one year and is renewable if agreed by both parties.

May the grace of the Lord Jesus Christ, the love of the heavenly Father, and the fellowship of the Holy Spirit grant me the grace, power, and strength to persevere in this Servants' Covenant.
